activity Barcelona Kurzentwürf is a design workshop involving constructive and architectural strategies to design street meeting places for the Barcelona 2026 UIA World Congress of Architecture. Case studies of temporary pavilions included in the Archive of the European Union Prize for contemporary Architecture – Mies van der Rohe Award will be confronted with student's design proposals for pop-up pavilions to be placed throughout Barcelona during the 2026 UIA World Congress of Architecture, aiming to serve as meeting places and devices for architectural culture dissemination.

Kurzentwürfe/short design projects are integrated short design modules held in the first semester of the Munster School of Architecture (MSA) Master study programme, in cooperation with international lecturers, via a network of renowned European schools of Architecture. ETSAB and MSA students will work in groups combining students from both universities.
