

INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP

This design-based course offers an in-depth look at Barcelona—historically and morphologically—across scales. By immersing themselves in the life of the city and partaking in series of site visits and original research, students will gain an understanding of the rich history of the city, its relationship to local culture and social circumstances, towards developing design ideas.

We will experience Barcelona's contrasting personalities: one focused on standard tourist destinations, the other looking in depth at the off-the-beaten-path neighbourhoods, with special attention to Poble Nou, where we will look at impacts of recent transformations.
